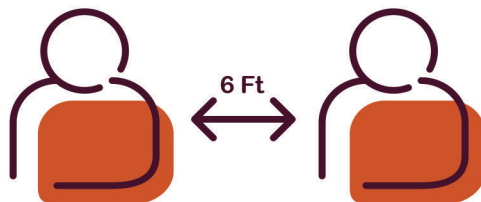


# Stay COVID-Safe

Being COVID-safe is a shared responsibility. We want you to enjoy the festival and stay safe. Please follow CDC guidelines and on-site directions when attending the festival.



Stay home if you feel sick or have symptoms. Stay home if you have tested positive or been exposed.



Maintain social distancing. Keep 6 feet between yourself and others especially when waiting in line.

- Picnic tables will be spread out and covers will be changed frequently.
- Kids' Zone activities will be sanitized frequently.
- Food vendors must follow all guidelines for food workers and food establishments.

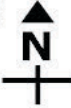

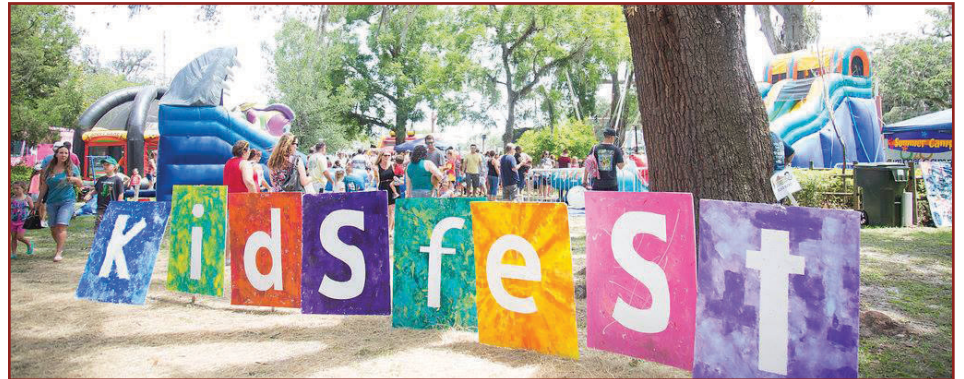


