# Business capacity rolled back

AUSTIN — The Texas Department of State Health Services announced Trauma Service Area R, which includes Hardin and Jasper counties, must roll back business capacity to 50 percent, and bar and similar establishments have to close due to the region exceeding the 15-percent threshold for COVID patients in all hospital beds for seven straight days.

The order took place at 8 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 22.

Also, elective surgeries must be postponed.

The 15-percent threshold for seven straight days automatically triggers the rollback specified in Gov. Greg Abbott's Oct. 7 order.

Hardin County Judge Wayne Mc-Daniel said the roll back will be in effect until Trauma Service Area R goes seven days at 15 percent or lower COVID-19 hospitalizations out of total hospital capacity.

"I really hate to see this for our local businesses as most have done an outstanding job protecting their employees and the public from exposure to COVID," stated McDaniel. "I will be requesting a waiver for Hardin County based upon the contract tracing investigations conducted to date which do not support the need to reduce capacity at our businesses."

Other counties in the Trauma Service Area R include Jasper, Newton, Galveston, Liberty, Chambers and Brazoria.

## Holiday closures announced

All federal, state, county, city and banks will be closed on Friday, Dec. 25, in observance to the Christmas holiday.

Also, county and city buildings will be closed early or entirely on Christmas Eve on Thursday, Dec. 24.

Also all banks and credit unions will be closed Christmas

The Silsbee Bee will be closed on Christmas, but will reopen for business at 9 a.m. Monday, Dec. 28.

All local school districts are closed this week and students are scheduled to return to class on Tuesday, Jan. 5.

## Council spends time reviewing expenditures, asks questions

The Silsbee City Council spent a lot of time reviewing expenditures for December before approval during the Dec. 21 meeting.

approval during the Dec. 21 meeting.

Councilmember Roy Gravis Jr. said he was particularly interested in a bill for Sun Coast.

The city rented a 1,000-gallon fuel tank during

a recent hurricane.

The rent was \$2,100 per week. Public Works Director Jose Pastrana indicated the city had the fuel tank for about three weeks, but that they notified Sun Coast early in the second week to come to get the tank.

Pastrana said the city was billed for three weeks but argued Sun Coast should have retrieved the tank after one week.

City Manager Dee Ann Zimmerman said she felt the city had the tank longer, possibly four weeks. Gravis questioned whether the charge of \$2,100 per week included the fuel and was told it was only for the tank.

If the tank was rented for four weeks, that charge would be \$8,400, plus the fuel cost, making the fuel pretty expensive.

Zimmerman stated the city would turn the cost of the tank and other generators and emergency equipment to FEMA.

Councilmember Thomas Tyler said if they had needed the fuel during the hurricane, it would have been "really important."

The council unanimously approved the expenditures.

The council approved the first reading of a resolution for the Silsbee Economic Development Corporation (EDC) to provide financial assistance of \$44,306.29 to Pamela A Taylor (Sweet Cheeks Cafe and Catering).

Councilmember Paul Davis made the mo-

"I'm here to give you my twoweek notice," laughed Sheffield. "I'm not changing my mind."

County Judge Wayne Mc-Daniel presented Sheffield with a certificate for his service.

"It is my great honor to recognize a legend in Hardin County," said McDaniel. "David has done an excellent job for this county for 30 years."

Sheffield noted he'd been the district attorney for the past 12 years.

"I hope you will come back and continue the races that you hold in the main hallway, ever so often," said McDaniel.

"Only if Gov. Greg Abbott comes down," replied Sheffield.

"It has been an honor to work with you and on behalf of the citizens of Hardin County, we want to thank you for all you've done," said McDaniel. "Just the fact that you got up every single day and worked, and have that office open to making sure the citizens are taken care of regards to justice and the district attorney's office is a testament."

Sheffield said the honor was "all his."

"There has been a fantastic bunch of people to work with and they have done a tremendous job," he stated.

Sheffield told Precinct 3 Commissioner Ken Pelt they were essential employees.

"We are essentially gone," he

Sheffield said he appreciated all the help and working with so many people.

"The county has been fantastic to me and I hope I gave back just a little bit of what the county has given me," he said.

Sheffield thanked Judge Steve Thomas for the access he was given to the District Attorney's Office to the courts.

"There is no way we would have gotten those maximum sentences or life sentences to kind of tame this rough county," he said.



## County reports another death

#### Family, social gathering attributing to spread of virus

HARDIN COUNTY County Judge Wayne McDaniel reported another death from COVID-19 in his weekly reported released on Dec. 16.

McDaniel reported a Silsbee woman in her 80s died on Nov. 22, after testing positive a day earlier.

"There are additional COVIDrelated deaths of Hardin County residents under investigation that will be reported once HCHD has confirmed data of those from Texas Department of State Health Services," stated Mc-Daniel.

Health Director Sharon Whitley attributed the continued increase in confirmed and probable COVID-19 cases throughout the county is largely due to spread of the virus through family and social gatherings.

"People have become complacent and let their guard down too soon, and are not always following the protocols to keep themselves and their families safe," she stated. "This has been confirmed through investigations of all reported COVID-19 infections in our county."

Whitley asked county residents to be patient with the Health Department staff.

"Any information we request from you is to help us identify possible outbreaks within the community and not to pry into in-

dividuals' personal affairs," she added.

McDaniel noted the area dropped below 15 percent threshold (14.39 percent) for hospital capacity on Dec. 14 which restarts the seven consecutive days of watching the rate for possible activiation of additional restrictions on businesses, according to Gov. Greg Abbott's Executive Order GA-32.

On Dec. 10, the Texas Department of State Health Services reported a 36 percent rate in the

As of Dec. 16, there has been 43 deaths reported, 22 from the Silsbee area, and 35 deaths from individuals age 61 and older.

The Dec. 16 report showed 431 active cases.

Since March, there has been 1,768 confirmed cases and 1,080 probable cases reported. There has been 2,374 people who have recovered.

Of the 43 deaths, there were 22 females and 21 males.

### Texas lawmakers consider bill to streamline SNAP

AUSTIN - Food insecurity doubled at the start of the pandemic, according to a study released earlier this year, and Texas groups that advocate for seniors say more must be done to find a permanent fix.

Kathy Green, manager of outreach and advocacy for 'AARP Texas, said legislation to be considered by Texas lawmakers in January would simplify requirements for people seeking help through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. For many older people, she said, the online SNAP process isn't userfriendly - but they need help with groceries nonetheless.

"We estimate that there's about 11 percent of the Texas senior population that faces food insecurity," she said, "and that is very likely underreported."

The Texas Legislature next month will take up Senate Bill 224, which is designed to streamline requirements for seniors and people with disabilities seeking SNAP benefits.

According to Celia Cole, chief

executive of the group Feeding Texas, thousands of agencies and volunteers helped with food distribution before the pandemic, but the virus forced a change in the distribution model. She said many food banks have closed their doors and fewer volunteers are available, meaning parking lots are used for assembly-linestyle food distribution, which not all seniors can access.

"Food banks are distributing 60 to 100 percent more food than they were prior to the pandemic," she said, "so that's been the biggest challenge, is just getting more food out into the community so we can keep pace with the demand."

AARP has noted that some seniors have difficulty navigating the internet to complete online SNAP applications. Green said they'd be more comfortable talking to someone on the phone which is one of many issues the legislation would address.

"For seniors, and individuals who are disabled, it would shorten the application," Green said, "and it would also extend the time period that somebody has to be recertified for SNAP."

## Tigers open 22-4A play with win over Orangefield

Silsbee falls to United for second time this season

The Silsbee Tigers opened up District 22-4A play with a 86-54 win over the Orangefield Bobcats on Dec. 15 in Orangefield.

Silsbee opened up the game with a 14-2 run as 6-foot-6 sophomore Jayce Jones scored the Tigers' first four points inside the paint. Shan Gilder Jr. hit six points and Jared Harris added four in the first period.

Orangefield's offense got untracked in the latter part of the opening period and was down 24-14 at the end of the first. Jones picked up two fouls in the first half of the first period and never returned to the court during the final 12 minutes of the first half. He finished with four points.

The Bobcats outpointed Silsbee in the second period, 17-6, and trailed at halftime, 40-31.

But in the third period, Silsbee started to pull away from the Bobcats. Six-foot-1 freshman Dre'lon Miller, playing in his second game, tallied eight points in the third to help carry the offensive load.

He finished the game with 16 points, hitting 6 of 9 from the floor and 4 of 4 from the freethrow line. Miller also grabbed seven rebounds.

Silsbee took a 63-44 margin into the final period.

Harris, a freshman, led all scorers with a game-high 18 points and he also dished out five

Three other Tigers were in double figures. Gilder and Jerrick Harper had 11 each, while Raymond Baltrip had 10 with a teamhigh 10 rebounds.

Others contributing to the scoring were Jayron Williams eight, LaMarcus Bottley six and Darron Grisham two.



The Tigers shot 60 percent from the floor (31 of 52) but was only 4 of 23 from 3-point range. Silsbee was called for 24 fouls

and the Bobcats had 11. Gilder fouled out.

#### **Beaumont United 109,** Silsbee 64

The Tigers took a break from district action and hosted the Class 5A No. 2 Beaumont United Timberwolves on Dec. 18. The Timberwolves left Silsbee with a 76-56 win.

On October 19, 2020, Entergy\_Texas, Inc. ("ETI") filed an application to amend its Transmission Cost Recovery Factor ("TCRF") with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission" or "PUC"). The application was assigned PUC Docket No. 51406. The proposed TCRF is requested in accordance with the Public Utility Regulatory Act § 36.209 and 16 TAC § 25.239. A TCRF allows a utility to recover its reasonable and costs that have occurred since the end of the necessar test year in the utility's last base rate case for transmission infrastructure improvement and changes in wholesale transmission charges to the electric utility under a tariff approved by a federal regulatory authority. In its requested amendment, ETI is seeking recovery of costs for transmission capital investments it incurred from July 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020. ETI also seeks to recover approved transmission charges that are not otherwise being recovered through rates.

The proposed TCRF as amended would result in total TCRF retail revenues of approximately \$51.0 million, which is \$31.6 million in incremental annual TCRF revenue beyond ETI's currently effective TCRF. This \$31.6 million amount would be a 3.3% increase in ETI's annualized nonfuel revenue requirement as compared to revenues approved in Docket No. 48371, ETI's most recent base rate case, and a 2.1% increase in ETI's overall annualized revenue requirement including fuel costs as compared to such revenues as approved in Docket No. 48371. The impact of the rate change on various customer classes will vary from the overall impact described in this notice.

The effective date of the proposed rate change would be the date that a Commission order adopting the proposed TCRF is issued. ETI has requested that, if no hearing is requested, the Commission adopt an order approving the proposed TCRF at or before its currentlyscheduled open meeting on February 25, 2021. All customers in ETI's Texas retail rate classes are affected by this request.







tion the money be distributed as a \$25,708 loan and \$17,598.29 grant. It was unanimously approved.

Approval of a second reading is needed in a week for final approval.

The council approved the annual city audit. Carla Dear of Belt, Harris, Pechacek, LLLP stated the audit received an unmodified opinion, which is the highest opinion that they could grant. She complimented the city for their excellent work.

Silsbee had total revenues of \$4,744,338 and total expenditures of \$5,837,009, which is a deficiency of revenues expenditures of \$1,092,671.

The city received \$3,380,380 from other financing sources such as transfers and capital lease for a net change in the fund balance of (\$712,291) and the ending fund balance of \$2,83,116, which is "very strong."

The council also accepted the annual audit of the Silsbee EDC.

The council approved a request from Mark Holcomb, the owner of Happy Kia to close 5th Street from Avenue H to Avenue G and then from the corner of Avenue H and 4th back to 3rd Street from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 30 for a chili cook-off to promote the "Save The Pines" project.

Silsbee EDC Executive Director Christie Brown assured the council she had checked with all the merchants in the area to be closed and there were no objections.

The council approved the expenditure of \$10,889.60 from funds for the Water and Sewer Reserved for Contingencies fund for electrical modifications for two new pumps.

Pastrana explained the pumps were already installed and after installation, they discovered the existing control panel and power panel did not work with the new pumps.

The council tabled a motion to spend \$23,582.39 for installing a new motor for the replacement of one in their bucket truck.

Pastrana reported his department originally planned to install the motor themselves but discovered that they did not have the proper lift to take the cab off of the truck to install the engine and some of the other equipment needed.

They first sought to purchase the new motor and installed it at Silsbee Ford.

But Silsbee Ford stated they could not install the motor and referred the city to Kinsel Ford in Beaumont.

Councilmember Roger Martin reported he checked with Silsbee Motor Company to install a new motor for \$20,000.

The council considered an ordinance to adopt the 2018 International Codes and the 2017 National Electrical Code.

Martin questioned how this would affect the area builders and zoning. He also wanted to know if it would require additional personnel for enforcement.

The ordinance passed with Martin and Tyler in opposition.

Councilmember Mark Muckelroy was absent from the 65-minute meeting.

The City Council, which also serves as the Silsbee Economic Development Corporation Board, met before the council meeting.

## Phishing scam asking recipients to validate information appears to target TDLR licensees

AUSTIN – An unknown number of people appear to have been targeted with an email that asks them to validate their profile information with the Texas Depart-

ment of Licensing and Regula-

TDLR did not send the email, and the agency urges anyone who received it to delete the email without clicking on the link or confirming or providing any personal information.

A TDLR licensee alerted the agency to the scam email. TDLR notified the Texas Department of Information Resources, and the TDLR Information Security team is investigating.

The email appears to come from TDLR but has a return email address that does not belong to the agency.

Recipients are falsely told that TDLR is requiring all licensees to validate their information no later than Dec. 24, or their next license renewal could be delayed. TDLR sent no such email.

If someone clicked on the link in the email, TDLR is advising them to reset their password on their TDLR account – and any other accounts they may have that use the same password.

It appears that the link in ques-

tion is no longer active, but everyone is reminded to protect their personal information while they're online:

• Never disclose your password to anyone, even a customer service representative from TDLR.

• If you are providing personal information to a state agency – or any company – make sure the site is encrypted before providing any personal information. Look for a key or lock on your screen. But do not assume this is safe, be sure you are connected to Texas.gov

• Use unique passwords when setting up an account. Don't reuse passwords and avoid using your date of birth, Social Security number, or simple words as a password. Use a password manager to assist in creating and tracking secure passwords.

• Avoid sending personal information via email unless the security method used is specifically outlined and the data is encrypted.

• Use a secure browser.

## Babin commits to Jan. 6 Electoral College objections, demands action

WASHINGTON, DC – U.S. Congressman Brian Babin (Texas, 36th District) issued a statement after sending a letter with eighteen House colleagues requesting a hearing to Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell, Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi, and several relevant House and Senate committee chairs.

Babin noted, according to the Constitution and federal statutes resolving federal election contests for the President, the Senate, and the House falls under the jurisdiction of Congress.

Babin's letter urged House and Senate leadership to investigate and conduct hearings regarding voter fraud and election theft so that Congress is fully equipped to address the legality of the Nov. 3 election.

"Confidence in our election process must be restored," said Babin. "It is my duty to do everything in my power to ensure that every legal vote is counted, every illegal vote is not, and our elections remain transparent. Our democracy will not survive otherwise.

"If Congress refuses to act before January 6, I will object to the electoral college vote submissions on the House floor on behalf of the millions of Americans, myself included, who do not trust the validity of this election."

Lindsey said some times she doesn't know what the toy is and has to research it to find out what the writer is requesting.

One writer was a "mile" long and requested every major toy.

Lindsey said some letters are "sad," and she sometimes doesn't know how to

## Couple merges trains with Christmas decorations

or Bo and Alice Roy of Lumberton, the railroad has been an important part of their married lives.

Even so, it's been incorporated into their Christmas trees and decorations throughout every room of their home, even the bath-

Bo worked for the railroad for 41 years before retiring in 2008 from Burlington Northern & Santa Fe Railway (BNSF). He started with Atchison, Topeka and Sante Fe Railways (AT&SF), which operated from 1859 to

At one time, the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway was the world's most famous transportation company. The AT&SF joined Burlington Northern in 1996 to create the Burlington Northern & Santa Fe Railway.

The couple, who has two children and four grandchildren, has been married for 53 years and during those years, Bo worked out of the Silsbee and Beaumont locations as an engineer.

Upon entering their residence, an holiday train display is set in front of the home. Approaching the house is a set of two metal train set — one painted and the other the original surface — on each brick ledge before entering the front door.

Upon entering the home, there is a small Christmas tree on a table in the entry hallway. There are metal ornaments from the railroad companies Bo worked for on the tree, along with small train ornaments.

"Burlington Northern and Sante Fe used to give us a metal ornament each year for Christmas," he said. "That's where it really started."

Alice noted the small Christmas tree stands inside a planter made from a small popcorn holiday bucket.

The kitchen also has an array of train trinkets and other memorabilia.

One piece is a large Sante Fe locomotive pulling an RV trailer decorated with a wreath and Christmas lights.

'Everyone asked me how do you get this one to run," Bo stated. 'You put cookies into it."

The train is a cookie jar. "Our daughter gave us the RV trailer last year and it didn't match anything I had," Alice said. "So I drew it into

Bo said they even have train-shaped salt and pepper shakers and a sugar and

creamer set. The highlight of the holi-

day decorations is a large Christmas tree in the living room covered with various types of ornaments, including trains and candy canes, small red lanterns, and train rib-

Alice noted she bought the lanterns at Walmart.

"When I saw them, I said they would go good with my train collection," she said.

Midway up the tree is a train track that circles the tree and on it is a small threepiece train that circles the tree at dedicated periods.

"This is not a kid-friendly train," added Alice.

In the bathroom, there's a train on the counter that plays music. Alice said a friend of hers from Silsbee said she's never been serenaded while using the restroom.

In another room, there is a display of locomotives and railway cars on a long table.

"They all will run because they still have the motors in them," said Bo. "There's a Burlington Northern and an old Sante Fe locomotive."

"I told him to fix it up like the trains are setting in the yard," Alice added.

They also have a train clock that makes a "railroad" sounds and plates given by the railway company.

'We have at least 15

plates," said Bo.

Also, they have a train from Cracker Barrel on display.

There are also several displays of their train memorabilia, which are displayed all during the year.


Bo said the trains merged into the Christmas decorations began with a small train set, which is displayed on a ledge over a fireplace.





living."
