• On **April 13, 1360,** a hailstorm kills an estimated 1,000 of King Edward's III's English soldiers in France. The heavy losses were seen as a sign from

God, convincing King Edward to negotiate peace with the French. • On April 10, 1866, the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) is founded in New York by philanthropist and diplomat

Henry Bergh after he witnessed and later wrote about work horses beaten

- by their peasant drivers in Russia. • On April 12, 1914, the Mark Strand Theatre opens to the public in New York City, the first of the "dream palaces," known for their impressive size and luxuriously appointed interiors. The Strand seated some 3,000 people.
- On April 11, 1945, the American Third Army liberates the Buchenwald concentration camp, near Weimar, Germany. Among those saved by the Americans was Elie Wiesel, who would go on to win the Nobel Peace Prize in 1986.



Town of Coventry 2019 Failed Septic/Cesspool & **Housing Rehabilitation Grant Funding Programs** Notice For Low/Moderate Income Homeowners

The Town of Coventry continually applies for grant/loan funds which become available through the Community Development Block Grant Program to assist qualified homeowners with necessary home repairs through grant funding. Up to \$10,000 can be awarded to income qualified households. Typically the awards are in the form of grants rather than loans. A forgivable lien, in the amount of the award, is placed on the property for 5 years.

Here are a few of the qualifications:

- The property must be owner occupied and current on your monthly mortgage payments for at least the last 12 months;
- Taxes and Homeowners Insurance must be current;
- There must be enough equity in the property to support the amount of the lien and the home must be in otherwise good
- The entire household gross income must be within the program guidelines of low-to-moderate for example:
 - o A 3 person household must have a gross yearly income added to 2% of their asset value to equal less than \$57,850.
- The following items qualify if the Program Inspector agrees they are at the end of their service years:
 - o Leaking or inadequate roofs;
 - o Failed septic system/cesspools and wells;
 - o Old furnaces not maintaining adequate heating;
 - o Old windows allowing for heated or cooled air to escape

Due to program administration requirements - minor; emergency; routine maintenance; mold related; electrical and hidden damage repairs do not qualify.





Asian Glaze Gives Turnips a New Flair

If you've run out of ways to prepare starches like corn, potatoes or rice to serve as side dishes, you might want to try turnips. We have Charles "Turnip" Townshend to thank for elevating turnips to the dinner table. England was formally introduced to turnips when Townshend, a British politician, imported Dutchgrown turnips in 1730.

Townshend wanted to use turnips as an inexpensive substitute for the hay that was

used to sustain cattle herds throughout the winter. In those days, it was expensive to grow and store hay all winter. To save money, many people killed their livestock in the fall, causing an overabundance of beef at one time. Townshend proved that turnips were an easy-to-grow, inexpensive way for farmers to fatten cattle through the winter, and a delicious vegetable "starch" for humans.

Although turnips contain a large amount of starch, they provide only

one third the calories as an equal amount of potatoes. Turnips are an excellent source of vitamins C, B-6 and E, fiber, folic acid, manganese, potassium and riboflavin.

Turnips are a member of the mustard family and are related to cabbage and cauliflower. They come in all shapes, sizes and colors. For the sweetest flavor, select turnips that are smooth, small, firm and heavy for their size, with some roots remaining on the bottom. Turnip greens also are delicious and even more nutritiously dense than the turnips.

Turnips can be peeled before cooking, eaten raw, sliced, made into a relish or a slaw, diced or julienned, or shredded to make croquettes. Turnips also can be used as a substitute for potatoes in many of your favorite

HONEY-GINGER GLAZED TURNIPS

Turnips are delicate, so cook them until they are still firm, but tender when pierced in the center with a knife. Overcooking will cause the sweetness of the turnip to diminish.

- pounds turnips
- tablespoons butter
- 1/4 cup honey
- teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 tablespoon soy sauce
 - teaspoon pepper
- 1. Wash and peel turnips and cut into 1/2-inch-thick slices, then halve or quarter the slices. In a pot of boiling, salted water, cook the turnips for 8 minutes or just until tender. Drain the turnips and stir in butter. Cook over high heat, shaking pan often, for 1 minute or until the turnips are coated with the butter.
- 2. Stir in honey, ginger, soy sauce and pepper to taste; cook, stirring often, for 1 minute or until glazed. Serve immediately. Serves 4.

Feral Cat Colony Getting

Out of Hand

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: We have

a number of feral cats living in the

wooded area behind our house. I

know that these cats normally can't

be acclimated to indoor living, but

watching their colony expand isn't

them to a vet and have them spayed

them somehow or release them



French 'Vide Poche'

An auction catalog called this strange dish a vide poche. It's a French term, but the English translation—"trinket box,""pin tray,""empty pocket" or "glove compartment"—wasn't very helpful. It looks like a lopsided bowl made out of cloudy cameo glass with a bug, spiders and leaves molded on both inside and outside. The thick glass is brown, green and orange. It is 6 inches wide, 5 inches in diameter. The bottom has the signature "Daum Nancy" and a cross.



No, it is not a bowl that was overheated and melted. It is a vide poche, a French dresser storage dish, a vintage form that is no longer popular. It was made by Daum, a famous French glass company that is now called Cristalleries de Nancy.

But we know what, where and why it was made. Do you empty your purse or pockets each night? This is a sophisticated storage dish for money and keys used in about 1900, a sort of storage dish for things needed frequently. Daum is a glassmaker who worked in Nancy, France from 1875. The company used the Cross of Lorraine as a mark. This vide poche was estimated at a New England auction for \$4,000 to \$6,000.

How do you tell a reproduction from the original when it comes to a bank? I have a Jonah and the Whale cast iron bank. It reads "Shepard Hardware Co., 1890" on the bottom.

A. The Jonah and the Whale mechanical bank was made by Shepard Hardware Co. of Buffalo, New York. The patent for the design was issued in 1890. Reproduction banks usually are slightly smaller than the originals. Check any iron that has lost its paint. Old cast iron is darker than new cast iron. If you see any rust, it's new cast iron. Paint on an older bank should show some wear. If the paint on your bank is too bright to be old, it probably is a reproduction. An old, authentic Jonah and the Whale bank sold at auction for \$1.650 in 2016. Reproductions sell for \$50 to \$75.

How much is a book called "National Encyclopedia of Business and Social Forms" worth? It was published in Chicago by G.W. Borland & Co. in 1882. The book has a leather cover.

A•You can buy an 1880 edition of this book for \$30-\$85. The 1882 edition with hard cover, not leather, sells for \$15-\$37.





Make sure you show the mover everything that needs to be moved, from the attic to the basement, and any sheds, garages or storage areas. The mover needs a complete picture of everything to be moved to give you the most accurate estimate.

Reputable interstate movers will always give you estimates in writing and they must—by law—provide you with federal publications that explain the moving process and your rights and responsibilities. Be careful of any estimates offered over the phone or online, and if the mover asks for a large down payment or full payment in advance.

- 2. Read your paperwork carefully. Remember, once you've signed a contract, you've agreed to what it says about your move.
- 3. Understand what the mover's level of liability is, in case of loss or damage.
- 4. Bear in mind that communication is key. Make sure the mover has your cell phone number or other way to reach you during the move and that you have the driver's full name and the truck number.
- 5. If you don't understand something, ask questions. Reputable movers will be happy to answer them. If the moving company can't or won't answer your questions, you might want to look for another mover.












transition spaces between the outdoors and the indoors that provide storage for footwear, wet clothes, sports gear, and other paraphernalia not wanted in the house - have grown in popularity as American homes have become bigger. "While mudrooms are not a new amenity, they've moved up on the list of must-haves for today's homeowner," says Linda Jovanovich of the American Hardwood Information Center, www. hardwoodinfo.com."As the amount of residential square-footage dedicated to mudrooms has grown, so has the attention paid to their design and aesthetics. Solid hardwood built-ins not only provide the customization needed in what are sometimes awkwardly configured spaces, but also create the opportunity to bring the warmth and character of natural wood to what is first and foremost a service room." Bob Near, renovation division director at Streeter & Associates, a Minneapolis-based home-building firm that installs myriad mudrooms, agrees: "For example, working with Peterssen/Keller Architecture and Eminent Interior Design, we recently completed a large mudroom with red-

birch cabinetry, part of the



makeover of a dated 1980s house. The client wanted a mid-century look, as if the room had been built in the 1960s, so its design is very clean." One wall is entirely floor-to-ceiling storage concealed behind plain slab doors; the other comprises a row of six locker-room-style open cubbies serviced by a single full-length bench. "The client also asked for unstained wood rather than painted cabinetry, for reasons of durability and aesthetics," Near continues. "First, they felt a clear polyurethane varnish would hold up better than enamel paint to the wear and tear imposed by four active boys. And second, they wanted to give the somewhat austere space a more earthy, homey feel." Easily applied by hand, the oil-based satin finish had the added advantage of deepening the tone of the red birch without changing

its color, an important consideration because the wood had been carefully selected for its not-too-pink, nottoo-green hue. As a whole, the project could serve as a terrific checklist of best mudroom practices: With six cubbies, there's one to assign to each member of the family, who'll then have an easily accessed set of hooks on which to hang wet weather gear; a stretch of solid bench on which to sit and take off dirty boots and shoes that can then be quickly stored in the deep cubbies underneath; a handy drawer for smaller items that might otherwise get lost; and all delivered in a beautiful, red-birch package. 


